Use whatever you have at home and make them as colourful as you like!</i></p>	<p><i>Can you create a repeating pattern using paint and objects around your home? Try potatoes, leaves, corks, or anything you can find! You could even use pens, pencils, or any materials you have to create your patterns.</i></p>	<p><i>Make your own play dough - Follow the recipe with an adult that has been posted on Google Classroom, mix together and have fun!</i></p>
<p><i>Play 'I Spy' using your sounds. Can you find your sounds in a story book?</i></p>	<p><i>Can you jumble up your number cards and then put them back in order?</i></p>	<p><i>Take part in the weekly Scavenger Hunts being posted and let us know how you get on by posting information or pictures on our P1 Google Classroom page.</i></p>	<p><i>With the help from an adult at home, can you log onto your Google Classroom and share something with your class? You could type your name independently or even share a picture!</i></p>
<p><i>Read a story with an adult using the ORT books provided or your own stories. Can you decide whether it was a happy or sad ending? Can you tell the person you're reading with why you think that?</i></p>	<p><i>When an adult gives you a number to 20, can you tell them which number comes before and which number comes after?</i></p>	<p><i>Log on to Cosmic Kids Yoga and enjoy some yoga at home!</i></p>	<p><i>Create an obstacle course in your home or garden! Use whatever objects you have around and see if you are able to complete the course. Have fun but please be careful!</i></p>
