Let's see how many of these activities you can complete this week.

Literacy

- Write out all your spelling words (from spelling list for wk 2) and your 4 Common Words. Look, say, cover, write and check the words.
 Remember to do your spelling task as well.
- 2. Try to do your active spelling task using different things writing, plasticine, pasta, stones, toys of your choice.
- 3. 20-30 minutes reading for enjoyment every day. This could be reading quietly on your own, reading to a pet, reading with a parent or sibling.
- 4. Writing. Choose any one of the pictures/story starters for this week. Remember to include a title. You can use your imagination, Literacy Shed from Glow or a piece of personal writing.
- 5. Draw or paint a spring picture. Write down words that tell what you see, hear, smell, feel and taste. Revise your spelling words.
- 6. Ask an adult/older sibling to test you on your spelling words. 30 minutes of reading for enjoyment.

Numeracy

- 1. Complete maths tasks from pack.
- 2. Create a time diary using AM, PM and 24hour time of a day at home. E.G. Woke up 07.45 am 0745.
- 3. 2 sessions at last of Sumdog and Prodigy
- Complete the Active Learn worksheets each day https://www.activelearnprimary.co.uk/start
