Let's see how many of these activities you can complete this week.



Literacy

1. Focus on your spelling words. Look, say, cover, write and check the words. Make up a silly or interesting sentence for each of your words.
2. 20-30 minutes reading for enjoyment every day. This could be reading quietly on your own, reading to a pet, reading with a parent or sibling. Remember to fill in your Reading Bingo Grid!
3. Choose a task on the Spelling Grid to complete.
4. Complete the Weekly Literacy Challenge – write a happy news report, using the template provided, and your work from last week.
5. Draw or paint a spring picture. Write down words that tell what you see, hear, smell, feel and taste.
6. Write for pleasure in Gaelic – this could be a song, a poem, a set of instructions, a recipe, a story, a letter, a diary entry, the list goes on!
7. Ask an adult/older sibling to test you on your spelling words – ideally on Friday!

Numeracy

1. Complete the Weekly Maths Challenge – this week is the SPICY challenge!
2. Create a time diary using AM, PM and 24hour time of a day at home. E.G. Woke up 07.45 am 0745.
3. Play Prodigy, SumDog, TopMarks or any other maths games.
4. Play the 1-minute Brain Teaser with an adult or older sibling asking you questions.
5. Complete any of the maths sheets provided.

Other Curricular Areas

Art - Draw a portrait of a family member.

PE – Take part in “P.E. with Joe” every day at 9am.

French - Teach the colours in French to someone in your house. You could then play French word bingo together.

HWB - Offer to help an adult with preparing your lunch.

Drama - Create a 30 second mime of a famous story that you know. E.g Goldilocks and the Three Bears. Ask someone in your house can guess the story. Remember- No sounds.

Science – Complete an experiment of your choosing! There are many experiments on YouTube which you could copy (with your parents' permission).
