<p><u>'Once Upon a Robot'</u> Can you create a story about the robot you have created for the competition above? What is your robots name? What does he look like? What can he do? What do you get up to together? 😊</p>	<p><u>Muddy Letters</u> Use a stick to draw the first letter of your name in the mud. Can you write your whole name or other words like mud, tree, bird or even your common words? You could make words from stones and sticks too. 😊</p>	<p><u>RM Easimaths</u> Log on to RM Easimaths through Glow and play. Let's see who can master some new Numeracy skills 😊. Remember certificates to celebrate your success of completing levels will be shared via ParentMail.</p>	<p><u>Can You Remember?</u> Make a tray of ten items from around your house (a peg, spoon etc). Concentrate on the items to remember their positions. Next, one person removes an item. The other person tries to guess what's been removed.</p>
<p><u>Oxford Reading Owl</u> Share one of the ORT stories provided in your home learning pack with someone at home and discuss the story. If you have completed these, use another story you have or https://www.oxfordowl.co.uk for free ORT ebooks 😊</p>	<p><u>Listening Walk</u> Go on a sound walk around your house, outside area or local area with an adult. Record what you heard by drawing the sounds. Talk about what you heard. Would you hear these sounds everyday? Would you hear these sounds in the morning/afternoon/evening?</p>	<p><u>Doing the Washing Numeracy Style</u> Can you complete these washing challenges? 1)Count in twos while matching socks 2)Sorting sock/items by colour and size 3)Matching/pairing up of socks of different lengths 4)Find five socks that are a different size. Can you put them in order?</p>	<p><u>Everyday Skills</u> Can you help your adults at home with more daily house tasks this week? For example, setting/clearing the table, helping with dishes, dusting, watering plants, helping with cooking and meal preparing etc. Let us know how you get on.</p>
<p><u>Star Spell</u> Visit the Star Spell website or app shared on our Google Classroom page and follow the guidance given to support learning of phonics and word building.</p>	<p><u>Sharing</u> Before a meal, help an adult to share the food between all of the plates. Can you make sure everyone gets the same amount? Can you cut your toast into four equal parts or into triangles during another meal? 😊</p>	<p><u>Shape Hunt</u> Look around your house and garden for 2D and 3D shapes, how many can you find and name? Draw the 2D shapes you have found then challenge yourself to make a picture out of these i.e. a shape house, a shape person.</p>	<p><u>Make Your Own Fitness Video!</u> Can you become Joe Wicks this week and create your own fitness routine/video? Get your family to join in by following your instructions/video. You could share this with us all if you want to on Google Classroom.</p>
