Literacy

1. Focus on your spelling words. Look, say, cover, write and check the words. Make up a silly or interesting sentence for each of your words.
2. 20-30 minutes reading for enjoyment every day. This could be reading quietly on your own, reading to a pet, reading with a parent or sibling. This could be a Gaelic book on Giglets. Remember to fill in your Reading Bingo Grid!
3. Using your PowerPoint from last week, and the guidance provided, write a book review on your favourite book in English.
4. Choose a task on the Spelling Grid to complete.
5. Keep a food diary this week, writing down everything you eat or drink in Gaelic. You will need to use a dictionary to look up some words.
6. Ask an adult/older sibling to test you on your spelling words – ideally on Friday!

Numeracy

1. Play Prodigy, SumDog, TopMarks, Easimaths, ActiveMaths or any other maths games – the Sumdog competition ends on Thursday this week!
2. Play the 1-minute Brain Teaser with an adult or older sibling asking you questions.
3. Complete any of the maths activities on Google Classroom.
4. Complete the Maths Sheets.

Other Curricular Areas

Art – Research a famous artist and try to recreate a piece of their art using materials you have in your house.

PE – Try to complete the activities on the PE Grid on Google Classroom.

French – Phone a friend or family member and try to have a whole conversation with them in French. Try and learn something new before you phone them to teach them!

HWB – Make a healthy snack for yourself every day this week. Be creative!

Science – Complete some of the activities posted on Google Classroom.
