#### What will this look like?

#### Integral to all Priorities

#### Priority 1

##### Outcomes

##### Improve health and wellbeing to enable all children and families to flourish in school

- Almost all children will identify the positive impact on their wellbeing following access to the SNUG & Outdoor learning, wellbeing experiences and specific targeted health & wellbeing interventions
- Attendance and late-coming of targeted children will show an increase of at least 5%
- All children will have increased opportunities for musical experiences which will impact on engagement and wellbeing

##### A few of the key tasks for this year...

- further develop Emotion Works helping supporting emotional wellbeing
- provide parent workshops on emotion works and promoting positive relationships and understanding distressed behaviour
- Further develop outdoor learning areas
- Increasing musical experiences for children across the school
- Further roll out Play Awards
- Support families where pupil attendance could be improved in partnership with the Youth Family Community Worker

#### Priority 2

##### Outcomes

##### Continue improvements relating to raising attainment in literacy with a particular focus on writing

- Across the school, there will be a closer alignment of CFE performance between reading and writing (aggregated data from P1,4,7) by 5%
- Close the poverty related attainment gap in writing by at least 10%
- Children will demonstrate increased motivation for writing
- School will be awarded the Reading School's Award

##### A few of the key tasks for this year...

- Promote a reading & writing culture across the school
- Review and reflect on how we are teaching writing across the school (story writing)
- Think about how we support children who find writing challenging
- Consult with children about writing at school and how we can motivate less willing writers
- Writers Extended learning club
- Targeted interventions with a focus on engagement and confidence building in writing

#### Priority 3

##### Outcomes

##### Raise attainment in numeracy

- Staff will be increasingly confident to teach numeracy
- Children across the school will demonstrate increased competence in numerical concepts
- Poverty Related attainment Gap will reduce by 4% in numeracy

##### A few of the key tasks for this year...

- Full staff training in Numicon
- South Lanarkshire Maths Strategy - Training for nominated staff in Maths Recovery Programme and begin to implement within pilot classes
- Purchase new maths resources and materials for classes across the school to promote mathematical play and active learning (Pupil Equity Funding)

Reducing the poverty related attainment gap included in all priorities above



Involving learners through increased pupil voice and participation

Ongoing rigorous self-evaluation and consultation with staff, children and other stakeholders

Working in partnership with families & the community with a focus on reporting on progress and increased curricular information (across priorities)
