- ·All children will have increased opportunities for musical experiences which will impact on engagement and wellbeing


# Continue improvements relating to raising attainment in literacy with a particular focus on writing

- Support families where pupil attendance could be improved in partnership with the Youth Family Community Worker


#### A few of the key tasks for this year\_

- Promote a reading & writing culture across the school
- Review and reflect on how we are teaching writing across the school (story writing)
- Think about how we support children who find writing challenging
- Consult with children about writing at school and how we can motivate less willing writers
- Writers Extended learning club
- Targeted interventions with a focus on engagement and confidence building in writing

#### Raise attainment in numeracy

-Staff will be increasingly confident to teach numeracy
-Children across the school will demonstrate increased competence in numerical concepts

-Poverty Related attainment Gap will reduce by 4% in numeracy







